## Training Schedule

Programme provided by Inverlussa Marine Services, Isle of Mull

- Start date of 24 June 2019; travel to Glasgow to complete 1-week basic training at Stream Marine Training:
  - ENG 1 medical
  - STCW Certificates: Fire Fighting; Personal Survival Techniques; Elementary First Aid; Personal Safety and Social Responsibilities
- Complete 2 weeks (Mon-Fri) at Inverlussa Mussel Farm, for initial practical assessment
  - Vessel ropework, anchoring and mooring operations
  - Basic Seamanship
  - Mussel Farm operation
- 3-week placement on Inverlussa Marine Services vessels (living onboard); the following will be covered:
  - Securing vessel for passage
  - Basic navigational watch keeping
  - Communication using equipment and visual means
- Return to the Mussel Farm in August and September to assist during the harvesting season (Mon-Fri)
- Placement on the vessels for remainder of the year, working on a scheduled rotation, to:
  - Spend time on various vessels in the fleet
  - Gain experience of fish feed delivery; fish farm site work, sea lice treatments, cargo runs and offshore work
  - Vessel construction and stability
  - Training on the use of vessel machinery and scheduled maintenance
- Additional training courses to be completed during the year:
  - RYA Day Skipper Theory
  - RYA VHF/SRC Radio communication ticket
  - NPORS Marine Knuckle Boom Crane
- Begin full time position after gaining the recognised qualifications in June 2020
